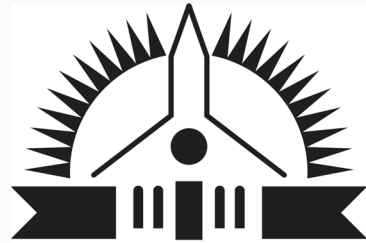

A Message From Brother Chad

Dear Church Family,

VBS is here! One of the highlights every year is to come into the sanctuary on the first day for VBS and see how it is decorated according to the theme. This year the theme is Twists and Turns, a celebration of all kinds of games that kids love. Our VBS runs from June 4-8 from 5:30-8:30 each night. Don't forget that this Sunday after church we will need several to drive for our annual VBS parade through the streets of Olney to remind people about our VBS. I will need at least 10 cars to be in the parade. Also, I am missing a few magnetic VBS signs that attach to the sides of cars. If you have those, please bring those on Sunday.

VBS is one of our largest evangelistic opportunities each year. The lessons are centered round the gospel message. I have heard evangelism directors for the various conventions in which we participate talk about how much of the evangelism progress being made these days is harvesting from seeds planted during Vacation Bible School years earlier. We realize most of the VBS work is planting seeds, but if we do not plant the seeds, there will never be a harvest.

This year for parent's night we will have a special treat. Alex Nsengimana will be sharing briefly about his experience of receiving an Operation Christmas Child shoebox as a boy in war-torn Rwanda. Alex will be speaking at Southside Baptist earlier that evening, but I'm glad our VBS students and workers will have a chance to hear him.

Save the Dates: Don't forget that June 11th we will have a special service for our FBCO 125th Anniversary celebration. We will have a BBQ meal on the grounds. Invite your family and friends to join us for this special occasion.

Reception for the Baileys: Join us at 6pm on June 18th to wish Jake, Holly, Katelynn, and Kendall well as they move to Cisco to begin new adventures there. Jake and Holly are a special part of our church family. We are going to miss their heart and service for FBCO, but we know that God will do amazing things through them wherever they go. Light refreshments will be served.

Work Day Report: On May 20 we had about 20-30 or so folks show up for the work day. We worked hard! We had crews that worked to wash down every table and chair in the church. We had crews cleaning walls, baseboards, and floors. There was also a crew that was doing yard work. The campus looks fantastic. Thank you to everyone who gave up their Saturday to come and serve the church. We all had a great time working and fellowshiping together.

Memorial Day Service: We were small in number but mighty in spirit this past Sunday for Memorial Day. I was especially touched by how beautiful the congregation sang on the patriotic songs. Join me in praying that God will grant revival and save this nation from the destructive path it is on.

Attendance & Giving: This past Sunday we were about 100 people off on our regular attendance. Remember, when you are gone, it makes a difference when you aren't here. If you are in town and well, be in your place for worship. Also, make sure that you are faithful in your generous giving even if you miss a service this summer.

Radio Ministry: This past Sunday, the sermon began to air on Olney's new radio station, Positive Country 104.3 FM. Each week, a sermon from FBCO will air at 9a.m. You can listen on the radio or on your phone over the internet at postiveradio.net. The cost of running the show on the radio is \$400.00 per month. This is a special, non-budget giving opportunity. If you are interested in helping with the radio ministry you can designate a gift to "radio ministry" each month. The 104.3 signal will carry from Wichita Falls all the way down to Cisco. The station has a huge coverage area and a great way for us to reach people all over this region.

Finally, I wanted to give a quick plug for the Graham Theater Summer Camp production of School House Rock, Jr. which will take place Friday (9th) and Saturday (10th) at 7 p.m. For the Friday night show, several of our students from Olney will be featured.
