A Message From Chad

Dear Church Family,

This has been such a heavy week for all Texans as we have seen our neighbors in southern Texas suffer from the effects of tremendous rainfall and resultant flooding. The death toll has continued to rise over the past few days. Continue to pray for those who have been affected by these events. Also pray for those who are helping. I am positive that there will be ways to personally help in the coming months of which we will be made aware. However, I want you to be encouraged. Because of your faithful weekly giving, you are helping already. Through our network of churches and the cooperative giving program of the Southern Baptist Convention, a small portion of every dollar given makes its way to groups like Texas Baptists on Mission, Southern Baptist Disaster Relief, the Send Relief Network of the North American Mission Board, and other agencies. These stand ready to help at a moment's notice. Chainsaw and clean-up crews, shower trailers, clothes washing trailers, meal preparation trailers, and chaplains that you support are down there now helping people in the name of Jesus. Thank you for your faithfulness.

One of the things that has made this flood so devastating are the stories coming out of the different camps in that area. We look forward to our youth and pre-teen camps each year. We are headed to pre-teen camp this coming Sunday afternoon. Would you pray for our safety as we travel and stay at Camp Chaparral? We are taking 43 students and several adults to camp this year. We hope to see the Lord move in the lives of everyone who attends. We will gather for camp at 1pm on Sunday the 13th and return in the late morning on Wednesday the 16th.

Our camp pastor this year is Kolby King, who is a dear friend of FBCO. Kolby will be here on Sunday leading a joint Sunday School class for our 1st – 6th graders. The joint class will be held in the class taught by Lyndsey Miller and the McClatchy's classroom upstairs. Please have your students there at 9:30 a.m. Kolby will also be sharing in our morning service.

Following preteen we have one more youth event this summer. Jaden is leading a group our youth on a mission trip to Paisano to help lead the children's ministry for the General Encampment meeting. This meeting has been taking place for over 100 years at the camp near Alpine, Texas. I'm excited that our students will get to experience the camp. They are also going to swim at the Balmorhea pool as part of the trip. Again, pray for safety and effective ministry for this mission trip.

Speaking of mission trips, Scot and Jessica Hayter left this week for their mission trip to Japan to work with the IMB missionaries that were featured in our VBS missions rotation last year. Pray they will have a wonderful and fruitful trip. Thank you for supporting their efforts.

Although it seems like the wheels are turning slowly, things are happening with our building program. The electrical work should be completed soon. The delay in the electrical upgrade has been due to a shortage of materials and equipment. Our contractors and Texas-New Mexico have done a great job locating equipment to keep these delays as short as possible.

Our building delay has mainly been to structural engineering related to the foundation design of our new building. The soil in the downtown area has a high clay content in certain places and special attention is required to make sure we are building on a good foundation. I think there is a sermon illustration in that somewhere! We learned last week that building plans have been submitted to the contractor and they are in the process of receiving bids from subcontractors. This will allow us to get a firm price on the cost of construction. I appreciate our property committee and their hard work in this area.

Lots of things are happening and the Lord is doing wonderful things in our church. It has been wonderful to see the baptisms of Philip Wallum and Brayson Betts these last few weeks. I'm excited for this next season of our lives and ministry together.
